CALLS FOR MOBILITY

The very first thing you have to do is wait for the CALL

- The call is an official announcement that students can send their applications for Erasmus+ mobility to their faculty coordinator
- The call is published on https://erasmus.tuke.sk/eu/prihlas--sa/ and on the social networks where TUKE presents itself (Facebook, Instagram). Each faculty also publishes information about the call on its faculty website

There are two types of calls:

- The main call is announced once a year in the period of FEBRUARY/MARCH for study and APRIL/MAY for traineeship
- An additional call is launched as long as there is still available mobility capacity after the main call has processed applications, usually in September (study) and November (traineeship)(can be launched for studies only or for traineeships only ... or both)

Watch the call for the date by which you can apply (send your application form)

Optional attachments to the application form

- A language certificate documenting your knowledge of the language (in which you study during the mobility)
- Other certificates documenting your knowledge/skills that you may find useful during your mobility
